As part of the initiative to promote entrepreneurship to young minds, PRIME

Meghalaya has funded 24 institutes across the state to invite and spark entrepreneurship at the Colleges and Universities. There has been a good amount of participation amongst the students who have shown interest though at the idea stage. For the last one and half years we have seen more than 500 ideas being generated across the program. Since being in the idea stage, PRIME has set up a program called **Student Tinkering Fund** where idea prospects have the opportunity to develop their ideas for prototyping.

At PRIME mentoring session are free for the entrepreneurs.



For registered PRIME entrepreneurs, there are four dedicated funding options available for the entrepreneurs of Meghalaya under the PRIME program depending on type and stage of business. Those funding opportunities are specifically targeted towards the Startup Entrepreneurs as well as Nano Entrepreneurs of the state who have the capability to scale up their businesses and create livelihood opportunities and jobs for many individuals in the state. Customized funding options have to be developed due to the fact that many innovation-based businesses are usually not eligible for bank-based loan funding and hence have to be supported dedicatedly in order to be able to grow. Namely, Kickstart Grant, Scale-up Innovation Loan, Small Support Grant and InnoVenture Grant.

Besides these, PRIME also has the CM-ELEVATE which is a State supported, credit linked flagship program, aiming to create a conducive environment for entrepreneurs to accelerate private sector led growth. The program is intended to stimulate economic growth and development through increased credit flow into the economy, entrepreneurship development, and job creation.

"PRIME Student Tinkering Fund up to Rs. 50,000" under the Support Mechanism: Entrepreneurship Promotion and Development Programmes (EPDP) and Incubators for Academic Institutes in Meghalaya PRIME has established a funding vehicle for students or student teams that are working on innovative entrepreneurship-related business and research ideas and concepts.

Based on recommendations brought forward by the E-Cells of the PRIME supported academic institutes in Meghalaya, an initial lump sum of Rs. 25,000 is disbursed directly to the student teams by PRIME.

Interest Free Loan for Food Processing: The Zero Interest Loan Facilitation Program is a lucrative initiative taken by the Government of Meghalaya in collaboration with Northeast Small Finance Bank to ease the access to credit. This particular program seeks to provide financial stability to the entrepreneurs of the state and motivate them to expand their businesses

further. Aspiring entrepreneurs of Meghalaya, who own food processing units and enterprises, were given the opportunity to apply for interest free and collateral free loans up to 10 lakhs. These loans are provided to the food processing entrepreneurs without any interest as the Government would be paying the interest on their behalf. This profitable opportunity will allow the food processing entrepreneurs to expand their business endeavors without having to worry about finances anymore.

Financial Support to Local Entrepreneurs Intending to Set Up Advanced Training Centres in Meghalaya: PRIME intends to support local Entrepreneurs from Meghalaya financially to set up training facilities in the state for conducting entrepreneurship-related and innovation-based training and capacity building in Meghalaya. The awarding will be through a competition for the best proposals.




