Subject: Reforms to be Implemented under Business Reform Action Plan, 2024 as per the mandate of DPIIT, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India.

Sir/Madam.

Inviting a reference to the subject captioned herein above, I am directed to say that the reforms set herein under Business Reform Action Plan 2024 shall be considered "NA2" for the State of Meghalaya as these reforms may not be applicable at this juncture. The Court of the District Judge, East Khasi Hills District, Shillong has been empowered to try cases under the Commercial Court Act, 2015 for the entire State of Meghalaya (vide Notification No. LJ(B)67/2016/49, Dtd. 9<sup>th</sup> February, 2021, enclosed as Annexure-A) and Commercial Appellate Division of the High Court of Meghalaya notified for the purpose (As re-constituted from time to time) [vide Notification No.HCM.III/49/2023/Judl.I/14 Dtd. 17<sup>th</sup> August, 2024, enclosed as Annexure-B].

At present, since there are fewer Commercial cases in the State, only the Court of the District & Sessions Judge, Shillong, has been notified by the State Government in consultation with the High Court of Meghalaya to function as the Commercial Court for the entire State and Commercial Appellate Court, High Court of Meghalaya notified by the High Court. However, as and when the need arises, more Commercial Courts may be notified (in each of the remaining 11 Districts) by the State Government in consultation with the High Court of Meghalaya. Further, it may be informed that the Court of the District & Sessions Judge, Commercial Court at Shillong have been utilising the existing service/assistance/staff/workforce of the District & Sessions Judge Court, Shillong.

Therefore, the question of ensuring filling up of 90% of the vacancies may not arise, since there is only one Commercial Court for the entire State with a Commercial Appellate Division in the High Court of Meghalaya. The total pendency of Commercial cases in the State of Meghalaya at the end of November, 2024 is 150 in the Commercial Court at Shillong and 5 in the Appellate Division. (Enclosed copy of data retrieved from the Official Website of the High Court of Meghalaya as Annexure-C) Thus, setting up more Commercial Courts in the State and filling up of the vacancies thereof may also be subject to pendency of Commercial cases in the State.
